☐ White-lipped Peccary <i>Herds around Sirena; give them room</i>

☐ Mantled Howler Monkey <i>The roar at dawn carries for kilometres</i>

☐ Central American Squirrel Monkey <i>The Pacific coast of Costa Rica and Panama only</i>	
☐ Brown-throated Three-toed Sloth <i>Out by day, often slowly climbing in cecropia trees</i>	
☐ Hoffmann's Two-toed Sloth <i>Mostly active at night; by day a ball of fur high in the canopy</i>
